## Pay Beds at Voluntary Hospitals in London 1939

**Lists of Special Hospitals and Hospitals providing Contributory Beds and Maternity Beds will be found on page 7. The figures given are the normal weekly charges. They do not include any medical or surgical fees.**

In nearly every case one or more of the following specific services, if required, are charged for as extras, either as an addition to the hospital charge, or as part of the medical fee: Anaesthetist; Exceptionally expensive drugs and dressings; Electrical treatment; Light treatment; Massage; Extra nurses; Operating theatre; Pathological examinations; Radium; X-ray.

Patients are normally attended by a member of the Hospital Staff, but may be attended by their own medical advisers, or, if rooms are available, by any recognized Ophthalmic Surgeon.

2 beds are available for patients who can afford about 3½ gns. a week, but not medical fees.
