FOREWORD

This working paper contains some basic information about statutory health centres in the United Kingdom. It is hoped that it will be of immediate use in its present form and, more importantly, that it may provide the first step towards the establishment of a comprehensive directory and information service on the subject.

Early in 1969 the King's Fund Hospital Centre held a conference 'A new framework for community care' at which Mr M P Curwen of the Department of General Practice, Guy's Hospital, drew attention to the serious lack of information about health centres. Later that year the Centre invited representatives of executive councils, local health authorities, the Society of Medical Officers of Health and the Department of Health and Social Security to discuss the possibility of starting an information service. Although it was clear that there was a need for more information, there was little agreement about the type of information to be collected. As a first step towards solving this problem, it was felt that it might be helpful to prepare and circulate a working paper which could serve as a basis for further discussion and development.

Despite its name, the Hospital Centre's activities have in recent years been increasingly concerned with all branches of the health service and the Centre therefore welcomed the opportunity to initiate this project. However, it is unlikely that the King's Fund would wish to support and develop the service indefinitely, for if this Directory is successful and if the need for its development is proved, it may be more appropriate for a statutory authority to take on the responsibility. However, the Centre is prepared to continue with the experiment for the time being, provided that users of the Directory are stimulated to offer correction, criticism, advice and information.

## INTRODUCTION

The health centre movement, which has gained such momentum in this country during the past five years or so, is one of the most striking ways in which the community health services are adapting themselves to changes in both the content and the organisation of medical care. As we have argued elsewhere\* much more information is needed about health centres before any attempt can be made to assess the value of the movement or to suggest how it should develop.

We believe that this Directory is a step towards meeting this need. It is primarily a list of all health centres in the United Kingdom which are now in operation, are being built, or will shortly be built. It contains the minimum information necessary to enable each centre to be identified geographically, to indicate the size of its general practice element and to specify some of the other services it offers.

One of the difficulties in collecting information about health centres is that there are no clearly recognised channels of communication such as exist in the hospital service. General practitioners are in effect tenants of local authorities and are under no obligation to provide them with detailed information of their activities. Many medical officers of health take an active interest in everything that goes on in their centres and members of their staffs often act as administrators - particularly in larger centres. But this is by no means always the case and no single individual necessarily has access to all the information that might be considered to comprise a complete profile of a health centre.

We have no wish to add to the work of health departments or people working in health centres by asking them to provide information of unproven value and at this stage have restricted ourselves to collecting about each health centre facts which are readily

available to medical officers of health. With only a few exceptions all the information in the Directory has been obtained in this way.

The Directory is mainly restricted to health centres as defined in the various Health Service Acts. We fully realise that there may be only a technical distinction between a statutory health centre and either a local authority clinic (such as those in the West Riding of Yorkshire) or a privately-owned group practice centre, in each of which general practitioners and local authority staff may work side by side. But it would have been beyond our present resources to have compiled even a list of such ill defined non-statutory centres. We have however made an exception by including (under Essex and Oxfordshire) the pioneer health centres financed by Nuffield at Harlow and Witney.

Our decision to restrict the information given in the 'other services' column of the Directory in the way described in the general notes on page 8 may need some explanation. We think it would be invidious to draw special attention to services such as maternity, family planning and school health clinics provided at some centres which at others might be taken for granted as being the responsibility of the GPs. It should be emphasised that the absence of particular services in this column does not necessarily indicate that they are not provided by the appropriate authorities. They may even be available in a neighbouring building. Our purpose in recording whether they are available within the health centre is that this is a convenient indication of the extent of actual potential integration between branches of the health services.

We see two possible uses to which this Directory may be put. Firstly it may prove useful to individual authorities, including regional hospital boards, to have a list of centres in their own and neighbouring areas. For instance it may help some local authorities, particularly those with little experience in health centre building, by suggesting to them where they may be able to

turn for useful advice. Secondly we hope that it will be useful to research workers interested in particular aspects of the health centre movement. For instance it makes it easy to distinguish between rural and urban health centres. Those who are interested in the development of the medical team may wish to restrict themselves to centres with, for example, more than four general practitioners. In view of the current interest in links between hospital and community we have tried to identify all centres visited by hospital consultants and those in hospital grounds.

With the exception of the Nuffield centres at Harlow and Witney, the Directory includes only those health centres established under Part III Section 21 of the NHS Act 1946 or the corresponding legislation in Scotland and Northern Ireland

The centres listed are those that were, on 1 October 1970, in operation, being built or formally approved for building by the appropriate government department.

For each health centre the information given comprises:

The year in which the health centre as such opened or is expected to open.

The address of the health centre in sufficient detail to allow its location on a map to be determined.

The number of GPs, on 1 October 1970 or on the expected opening date, whose work in or from the health centre amounts to a half or more of the normal working week.

The number of GPs, on 1 October 1970 or on the expected opening date, whose work in or from the health centre amounts to less than half the normal working week (ie using the centre as a branch surgery).

The number (to the nearest 500) of patients on the NHS lists of the GPs at 1 October 1970 who may be seen in or from the centre. The column is left blank in those instances where the information has not been made available by the executive council. In the 'other services and remarks' column is recorded a list of health services provided within the health centre by distinct professional groups not considered as part of the usual GP/local health authority team of doctors, nurses and health visitors. The following services are included wherever they have been reported:

If the health centre has special links with a hospital, this is recorded, and if the centre has been more fully described elsewhere a reference to the bibliography at the back of the book is included.

In the last column is recorded the responsible local health authority and the name of the medical officer of health to whom requests for further information or to visit centres should be addressed.

COMMENTARY

In our previous study\* we predicted that there might be 300 statutory health centres open in the United Kingdom by the end of 1971. Analysis of the information collected from medical officers of health for this Directory shows that by the end of 1970 the total count was 254 and that by the end of 1971 it may approach 400.

Table I (overleaf) gives the numbers of health centres opened year by year. In 1970 81 new centres were opened in the United Kingdom, almost 30% more than in the previous year and considerably more than the entire number opened in the twenty years 1948-67. At the time when the information was recorded local authorities could clearly not be certain of the opening dates of centres still under construction and the high figure for 1971 (127) coupled with the lower figure for 1972 (68) probably reflects their optimism rather than the true probability. Also there may be some completions during 1972 (and of course 1973) of centres whose plans had not been approved by 1 October 1970.

A clearer picture of the likely rate of health centre building in England and Wales emerges from a study of the graph (page 72) which gives cumulatively the numbers of centres in the four categories recognised by the Department of Health and Social Security:

- I Open
- II Being built
- III Approved for building
- IV Being actively planned (not yet approved)

Very few centres are taken out of the 'pipe-line' once they have reached category III. It may therefore be deduced from the graph that the average time between approval and opening is slightly more than two years. Assuming that this interval remains more or less constant we may expect to see up to 90 new centres per year being opened in England and Wales in the next two years compared with 60-70 in the immediate past.



Services provided in health centres

An original aim of the health centre was that it should provide a meeting place for all branches of the health service. We have attempted to find out to what extent this aim is being achieved but, largely owing to difficulties of definition, we have not recorded the full range of local authority services and have confined ourselves for the present to a small number of easily defined services provided by distinct professional groups. It may be taken however that in virtually every health centre there is some degree of local authority involvement.

Table II shows that of all statutory centres built or approved in the UK a large proportion will have some services relating primarily to the school health service, the commonest being dental services (52%) and speech therapy (22%). Physiotherapy is recorded against some 14% of the centres but it is probably usually restricted to remedial treatment for handicapped children. Only the RHB would normally be empowered to provide a full range of physiotherapy services in a health centre and we know of no instance where this is yet done, although it may be planned for the future in some centres. Chiropody, presumably mainly for old people, will be provided in about two-thirds of the centres. It must be stressed that absence of any of these services from our records does not indicate that they are not easily available to patients of the centres. We are simply concerned with services available under one roof.

All but three of the centres listed in this Directory make provision for general practitioners. On the other hand general dental services (as opposed to school and priority dental services) figure in 40 centres - less than 9% of the total.

The extent of hospital involvement in health centres is difficult to determine with accuracy. Regular consultant clinics are recorded for 58 centres (all in England and Scotland), the commonest specialties being ophthalmology, psychiatry and orthopaedics. We have not distinguished between clinics undertaken

directly on behalf of RHBs and those undertaken by hospital specialists as part of the school health service. Possibly most of the specialist clinics recorded in the Directory fall into this latter category.

A particular feature of the Scottish centres is that 11 of them (22%) are in the grounds of hospitals. The corresponding figures for the rest of the UK are very much smaller - 12 out of 409 (3%). Two centres in London and one in Wales are linked for teaching purposes to medical schools.

# Size of health centres

The ideal measure of the size of a health centre would be the number of people for whom it offered a comprehensive service. But few centres do offer a comprehensive service and catchment areas may differ for different functions. Also some GPs are unwilling to reveal the size of their lists. The only measure we can use is the number of GPs using the centre and even this is of doubtful value where centres are used largely as branch surgeries.

We have made an arbitrary distinction between GPs working for a half or more of their time in a particular health centre and those who, working for less than half their time there, are presumably using it as a branch surgery. Using this rough-and-ready definition the centres listed in this Directory will be used as branch surgeries by 391 'part-time' GPs out of a total of 2480.

Most of these 391 GPs work in 44 centres (all but 3 in England) which are used as branch surgeries by the <u>majority</u> of their doctors. These centres are excluded from Table III which gives the sizedistribution of the remainder. The average number of GPs per centre is 5.9 in Scotland, 5.3 in England, 5.1 in Northern Ireland and 4.0 in Wales. A third of all the centres in the country provide for less than 4 doctors. Many of these small centres are in rural areas but even in London the proportion is no less than in the rest of the country. At the other end of the scale are 44 centres with provision for 10 or more GPs. These are fairly evenly scattered over the

country although 4 of the 7 centres with 15 or more GPs will be in Scotland. The largest health centre so far approved is that at Redditch with 26 GPs.

Although these large centres tend to make news there is little evidence of more than a slow increase in the average size of health centres. The following figures give the average number of doctors per centre (including 'part-time' GPs) for the whole of the UK according to the year of opening:

Conclusion

To assess the part played by health centres in the integration of the health services requires a much deeper study than is permitted by the information in this Directory. We need to know something of both the cost and the quality of the care they provide. Experience from the hospital field shows that it is possible, although not easy, to achieve meaningful costing

figures but measurement of the quality of care raises more fundamental difficulties. But in order to justify the widely held assumption that integration leads to an improvement in the quality of medical care, we must first assure ourselves that health centres do promote integration. Perhaps the first step should be made by finding indicators of the degree of integration that is achieved. What sort of staff use the health centre? What are the relationships between them? What are the links with the local hospitals - particularly in respect of diagnostic and casualty services? These and many similar questions must be answered if, as we wrote in 1969 'we are to avoid saddling the next generation with unsuitable buildings and inhibiting rather than promoting the development of the service'.

This Directory will have served a useful purpose even if it does no more than provide a sampling frame for such inquiries.
