



In January, 1932, His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales, President of King Edward's Hospital Fund, appointed a Committee of Inquiry, consisting of the Earl of Onslow (Chairman), Sir John Rose Bradford, Bt., Lt.-Gen. Sir George Macdonogh, Dame Helen Gwynne-Vaughan, Sir Ernest Morris, Sir Francis Fremantle, M.P., Sir Isidore Salmon, M.P. and Mr. R. H. P. Orde; to inquire into and report upon out-patient methods as affecting the suitability of the patients and the time of waiting. The Committee reported in December, 1932.

The general conclusions of the Committee were that part of the waiting was unavoidable with large populations, but that part was due to the treatment of excessive numbers of minor cases which could be dealt with by various other agencies described in the Report, and that part was sometimes due to remediable defects in procedure or in accommodation.

The Committee recommended, therefore, that the present movement towards the more consultative use of the out-patient departments, except for emergencies, should be encouraged, provided that a patient desiring to attend a hospital, and unable to pay a consultant's fee, should have access, at least once, without a doctor's letter; that various time-saving methods of procedure or improvements in accommodation, already adopted or suggested at some hospitals and described in the Report, should be studied by all hospitals with a view to action where appropriate; and that the King's Fund should consider to what extent it could help to carry out these recommendations by making more detailed information available or by other relevant methods.*

In order to carry out this last recommendation, His Royal Highness the President, in January, 1933, appointed a Committee, consisting of Sir John Rose Bradford, Bt. (Chairman), Dame Rachel Crowdy, Sir Ernest Morris, Sir Isidore Salmon, M.P., Mr. Eric Pearce Gould, Lt.-Col. A. P. Irwin and Mr. R. H. P. Orde; to consider, in consultation with the hospitals, what steps it would be practicable and advisable for the King's Fund to take; and to take such steps as the General Council or the Management Committee should approve.

- 1. The Report of the Out-patient Committee recommended that, though the bringing of doctors' letters should not be made compulsory, it should be encouraged in the interests of the patients, the hospitals, and the general practitioners; and that co-operation between hospital consultants and general practitioners should be facilitated by the adoption of standard forms for doctors' letters and hospital replies.
- 2. The Report also suggested that the use of the standard forms might afford an opportunity of drawing attention to the importance of patients being sent to hospital at the proper times, and that the hospitals should keep general practitioners informed as far as possible of the proper times by the issue of out-patient time-tables on more or less uniform lines.
- 3. We have given early consideration to these recommendations, in view of the fact, mentioned in the Report, that both the British Medical Association and the London Panel Committee had already had the question of standard forms under consideration, and that the British Medical Association had a model form in preparation.

I. STANDARD FORMS FOR DOCTORS' LETTERS AND HOSPITAL REPLIES

4. The action of the British Medical Association and the London Panel Committee in promoting the use of standard forms is greatly to be welcomed. The Out-patient Committee received evidence of the difficulties that arise when patients are sent with "only a doctor's visiting card or a scrap of paper which gives no information about the case." The remedy for this clearly lies with the doctors themselves and cannot be effected by the hospitals.



- 5. Several of the hospitals already have printed forms of their own for the use of their consultants in reporting to patients' doctors. Some of these forms contain headings for different sections of the reply, or introductory words to reduce the amount of writing needed. Some consultants prefer not to use any form at all, but to write personal letters. The Out-patient Committee reported in favour of the provision of shorthand and typing facilities by the hospitals for the use of such of their consultants as would be glad of them. Whatever method particular consultants may prefer to employ in practice, it is an advantage that the standard form should be a joint one, providing a page for the hospital reply as well as one for the doctor's letter.
- 6. A specimen of the form drawn up by the British Medical Association is printed in facsimile as Schedule I to this Memorandum. It is stated by the British Medical Association to represent a model suitable for the whole country and capable of modification for particular localities where minor variations may make it more acceptable.*
- 7. An alternative form issued by the London Panel Committee based on the British Medical Association model, but with minor variations, is reproduced in facsimile as Schedule II.†
- 8. Our conclusions on this part of our subject are as follows:—
 - (i) that these forms are well adapted to serve the desired objects by providing:
 - (a) a convenient form on which the general practitioner can give particulars of the patient's history and condition: this is far more useful to the hospital than a visiting card from the doctor, and saves the time both of the hospital consultant and of the patient;
 - (b) a separate detachable page for the consultant's reply, so that the hospital can retain the general practitioner's original report among the patient's record papers;

We understand that the change in the wording of the first part of the form is intended to emphasise the readiness of the National Insurance practitioner to continue the treatment of his insured patients himself unless the hospital consultant wishes to retain them at the hospital.

- (ii) that, in the absence of an agreement on a single standard form, the hospitals should encourage the use by general practitioners of whichever of the two forms the individual practitioner may prefer;
- (iii) that hospitals could usefully encourage the use of the forms by keeping a small supply and taking opportunities of bringing them to the notice of general practitioners: e.g., by asking their medical staffs to use the form intact when reporting to a doctor whose patient has come without an introduction or with only a visiting card.

II. HOSPITAL OUT-PATIENT TIME-TABLES

- 9. Out-patients frequently come to hospital on the wrong day or at the wrong hour for receiving the particular kind of attention they need. When this happens they may have to wait a long time, or they may have to go away and come again. In either event they may suffer hardship.
- 10. One remedy for this would be the preparation and issue of hospital out-patient time-tables, in a form which would render the necessary information readily accessible to general practitioners.
- 11. Most hospitals print time-tables, of one kind or another, according to the purpose for which they are intended. The sizes range from a postcard up to a foolscap sheet. Most of them give the hours for the attendance of the individual consultants. Some of them are issued to general practitioners using the hospital, or to prospective out-patients. Others are not suitable for this purpose. Some of the books of reference which give particulars of individual hospitals include the days and hours for out-patients.
- 12. After considering various alternatives, we have come to the conclusion:—
 - (a) that a simple form of general out-patient time-table would be useful, including in alphabetical order all the hospitals in the King's Fund area; giving, for each hospital, the day and hour for every department to which a new out-patient can obtain access direct and not by reference from some other department; and containing blank space in which a general practitioner can write the names and times of the consultants to whom he is most likely



to send patients: he will probably be already in touch with these consultants or with their hospitals, and can thus easily obtain this additional information, especially if the time-table gives the hospital telephone numbers;

(b) that the table should be so printed that it can be used as a separate pamphlet or can be inserted by the recipient in his telephone directory, whichever he may find most convenient; and should be revised by the King's Fund at intervals so as to keep it up to date.

A specimen table giving the times in force at the end of September is printed as a Supplement to this Memorandum. Copies of this, prepared on the above lines, have been circulated by the King's Fund to all the doctors in the Fund's area, viz.: 11 miles round St. Paul's, together with specimens of the Standard Forms. But it might also be useful if Hospitals were to take advantage of suitable opportunities of mentioning the subject to General Practitioners with whom they are in touch.




