PREFACE

In the prefatory notes to last year's edition of the Blue Book it was said that in future the opportunity would be taken of conveying to hospitals and homes in the foreword any information which the Fund might wish to notify regarding the compiling or layout of the Statistical Summary.

Points concerning the creation of a maintenance reserve and the writing off of expensive capital equipment were dealt with in last year's preface. In that preface the method of calculating provisions costs was also mentioned and it was indicated that in future, apart from the usual column showing the cost per occupied bed per week, there would in addition be figures based on the cost per person fed. This additional information does in fact now appear in this year's Summary and it is believed that for comparative purposes it gives a more satisfactory base for the calculating and assessing of provisions costs.

The Blue Book is compiled at The Hospital Centre and it is hoped that hospitals and homes will forward any queries which may arise from these notes or elsewhere. The staff concerned at The Centre are desirous of helping in any way possible and letters should be addressed to 24 Nutford Place, W1H 6AN.

In conclusion to this preface attention should perhaps be drawn, as in previous years, to the fact that comparisons based solely on figures should be viewed with caution. It must be borne in mind that there are many factors attaching to the running of hospitals and homes which may lead to apparently surprising differences in costs, as between one and another, which could only be explained by a more detailed examination of the circumstances.
