Subcaste name indicating family's traditional



FIRST NAME is personal

SECOND NAME is female title or second personal name

Normally no shared family name

Some women in Britain may use one eg Razia Khatoon Iqbal



Use last part of name as surname for filing Note name of Father/Husband for extra indentification

Full name is usually two or three parts

Order does not indicate usage

First name may not be personal name

(Personal name can be first or second)

Last name not usually a shared family name

Mohammed Safdar Habib Ullah
Mohammed Ibrahim Mohammed Yunus Choudrey
Suleiman Mia Bahadur Khan
Mohammed Khalid Qureshi Allah Dillah

Religious name used with personal name = calling name

Mohammed, Allah & Ullah always religious names

Ahmed, Ali & Hussein often

Many other possible religious names

Following calling name there may be another name (usually only adopted in U.K.)


Usage:

Formal & Official: Full name

General informal: Calling name (usually personal + religious)

Close friends & family: Personal name

Always use title + full name for formal and official usage



First Name:

Used by family and friends

Names can be both male and female

Names often end in -jit -inder -want

Middle Name:

MALE: SINGH

FEMALE: KAUR

Used with first name eg Baljit Kaur

Often regarded as most important part of name

Religious titles, do not identify anybody

Surname:

Subcaste name, traditionally not used for

religious reasons


May be readopted after some time in Britain
